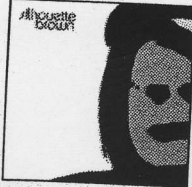

Take two of the most respected behind-the-scenes players from Britain's dance music world (Bugz In The Attic's Kaidi Tatham and 4Hero's Deigo), put them in the studio with two fine vocalists (Bembe Segue, who features on Ty's Mercury-nominated *Upwards*, and jazz singer



Deborah Jordan) and the result is an album of blistering soul with alternative production. It's true that Silhouette Brown lacks the grit and bump of the broken beat dancefloor sound. Instead, with

Jordan's lead vocals and Segue's songwriting, combined with further layers of melody, psychedelic keys and dreamy pads, Silhouette Brown have added another dimension to broken beat – this is about as sophisticated and inventive as soul music gets.
